Selection Committee Responsibilities & Conduct

The Polocrosse Australia Selection Committee is responsible for assessing Player Nominations and making selections.

As a Selector you will be part of the Committee responsible for the selection of National Squads and Teams. You will be required to attend meetings and Tournaments, including National Championships, State Championships and the Australian Junior Championships; your travel and accommodation costs will be met by the Association.

Responsibilities of the Selector

1. Declare any issues or conflict of interest, prior to accepting membership of the committee; also declare any issues or conflict of interest if they arise during your tenure.
2. Ensure your criteria and the methods of assessment are documented.
3. Assess applications and shortlist nominees.
4. Approach the selection process with neutrality and confidentiality - Information provided by candidates and the proceedings of the Committee are confidential.
5. Actively participate in the process.
7. The Announcement of Selections must be treated in the strictest of confidence and will be undertaken as follows:
 - The Chairman of Selectors will advise the Board of selections prior to ANY public announcements.
 - The National Executive Officer will announce the Selection on the Polocrosse Australia website.**At no point are Selectors to discuss the Selection outcome outside of the Committee. If Selectors are approached for comment they should refer all inquires to the PAA website.**
8. After attendance at a Tournament Selectors must forward player assessment notes to the Chairman of Selectors and the non traveling selectors, within 10 days of the Tournament.
9. A Selector is an Ambassador for Polocrosse Australia and the Sport of Polocrosse, and as such is expected that Selectors possess a high level of communication and Interpersonal skills; are honest in all dealings; adhere to Polocrosse Australia Policies and maintain a high standard of personal presentation and behaviour.
