### NSW Coaching Director

#### Purpose of Position:

The State Coaching Director is responsible for the appointment, coordination, administration and general supervision of all NSWPA accredited coaches.

To develop and improve coaches so that players are able to maximize their potential at all ages and at all levels.

#### Duties / responsibilities:

- Advise the NSWPA and NSW Council on all matters relating to the coaching;
- Co-ordinate & manage the NSWPA State Coaching Sub – Committee which is a committee of all the Zone Coaching Directors;
- Assume the position of Chairperson of the NSWPA State Coaching Sub –Committee;
- Recommend to the NSW Board the appointment of Coaches to roles that are appropriate to their level of experience, skills and abilities;
- Plan, manage, support delivery & monitor the accreditation programs of Level One Coaches in NSW;
- Provide support & encouragement to Level Two & Three Coaches;
- Provide ongoing professionally development to all accredited NSW Coaches;
- With the assistance of the NSWPA SEO, maintain a current listing of accredited NSW Polocrosse Coaches;
- In consultation with the NSWPA Board, the Zone Coaching Directors, and the Junior and Intermediate Development Officers, develop a coaching plan and associated budget and provide recommendations to the Board for the annual allocation of resources;
- Approve any awards connected with Coaches.
- Provide appropriate outcome and financial reporting to the Board and Council regarding conduct of Coaching programs and development of Coaches.
